JOB DESCRIPTION

The green roof maintenance technician is responsible for the maintenance and care of new and existing green roofs under the direct supervision of the Superintendent. You will be expected to perform green roof installations with other crews when not conducting maintenance. This is a seasonal position; months of operation run from April to December. We are a union company and travel frequently to other cities across Ontario.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Follow safety programs and policies.
- Physical labour such as; bending and crouching, loading and unloading materials, grading of soil and aggregates and the distribution of materials throughout work areas.
- Horticultural maintenance practices include: Weed identification and removal, pruning, and watering.
- Field documentation: prepare reports and make observations on the health of green roofs.
- Clean and organize work site and truck.
- Operate hand and power tools
- Installation of various types of green roof systems; modular and built-up systems.
- Installation of landscape construction; walkways, concrete pavers, patios and wood decking.
- Direct and control traffic around work areas.
- Signal various equipment operators when maneuvering materials.
- Travel to jobsites throughout Ontario.
- Must have reliable transportation to the office.
