Job Summary:

The successful applicant will join the Tourism Attraction Board management team and will report to the General Manager. The candidate will be responsible for performing landscaping activities such as planning and layout of projects, planting, pruning and cultivating shrubs, trees, orchids, turf, flowers and pesticide applications. This position will inspect and monitor the conditions of the landscape to assess horticultural or environmental problems; work with the General Manager to recommend improvements to existing and new garden areas with specifications when needed.

Responsibilities include:

- The post holder will perform landscaping activities such as, planting and cultivating shrubs, trees, turf, orchids, flowers and pesticide applications.
- Operates/utilizes a variety of equipment or tools associated with activities involving truck, tractor or backhoe.
- Develops plant inventory, utilizes diagnostic instruments, cameras and global positioning systems.
- Inspects and monitors the condition of the landscape to assess horticultural or environmental problems.
- Assists in the preparation of reports, documents inspections, photographs property conditions and maintains required records; planning and layout of projects.
- Send email correspondence to vendors, prepare purchase orders, time sheets reports, etc. and uses other computer programs.
- Prepares specifications for bids/quotes for various landscaping contracts as needed.
- Assist in all other duties as assigned by Management.

Qualifications & Experience:

- Bachelor's degree in horticulture or diploma from a recognized three (3) year horticultural program arboriculture forestry or related field and three (3) years of experience in botanic gardening, landscape construction, agronomy or landscape maintenance work.
- Candidate must possess working knowledge of practices and techniques of landscape construction, horticultural care, agronomy or landscape maintenance; knowledge of tropical plant life as applied to ornamental horticulture; of plant materials, plant techniques, erosion control and pesticides.
- The post-holder must interpret and enforce the policies established by the General Manager
