Knowledge of bedding, exhibition plant culture and performance, suitability for designs, creative design skills of bedding plants, conservatory and events. Experience with Health and Safety, the Health and Safety Act, inspections, incident reports, procedures, budget management, report preparation is required. Experience with Microsoft Office is required. Experience required in Horticulture teaching with lectures and evaluations.
